Voluntary Refund

Handling instructions for travel agents:

- Travel agents may not use automated refund tools (e.g. Amadeus Ticket Changer, NDC TrueReshop, Travelport Rapid Reprice, etc.). Manual processes apply.
- Waiver not required provided TWP conditions are fulfilled.
- You can do the refund for unused tickets in accordance with this Ticketing Waiver Policy (TWP 2503) and entry of the waiver code without having to request a waiver from your Lufthansa Group Agency Support.
- Partially used tickets: Please raise refund application via BSP or other local processes (in non-BSP markets).
- All transactions are subject to audit. Non-compliance with TWP rules will result in an Agent Debit Memo (ADM).

Refund mask:

Mandatory entry of "TWP2503" in waiver field / airline authority box of the refund mask.

- Amadeus: TRFU/WA TWP2503
- Farelogix-SPRK: Enter "TWP2503" in the Refund window / Waiver code box
- Galileo/Travelport: Start direct refund via TRNE entry. Enter "TWP2503" in the waiver box
- (A/L authority).
- Sabre: After direct refund "WFR" entry, enter "TWP2503" in the waiver box
- Infini: Enter "TWP2503" under Refunds Reason Code
